## NEW HSBC UK MOBILE BANKING APP IS NOW AVAILABLE TO ANDROID CUSTOMERS

- App available to Android users from today
- Regular updates for 2017/18 to increase application functionality
- Report Lost or stolen card feature available to both Android and iOS users

The new HSBC UK Mobile Banking App is now available to Android customers launching today (8 December). The app which is already available to Apple customers will now be available on all Android devices. It has improved features, including the ability to add new payees and to report your debit card lost or stolen directly from the app itself. The new app will benefit from regular updates that deliver new functionality to enhance the overall customer experience into the New Year.

Since 2016 there has been over a 20% increase in the number of customers using the HSBC mobile banking app. Following detailed customer research the new app has been designed with improved functionality including the ability to add new payees, and a 70% reduction in login time.

Raman Bhatia, Head of Digital, UK & Europe said:

“Customers tell us they want to be able to do their banking on-the-go seamlessly. Our new mobile banking app has been designed to improve that experience, with a quicker login time the ability to add new payees, and the option to report a debit card lost or stolen. We will build on these features throughout the course of this year and next, introducing new services, such as Pay by Bank App, via a series of regular updates.”
